## 2010 - 2011 Registration Policies and Procedures

We will do our best to accommodate 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> choices, but *requests are honored on a first-come, first served basis*. Forms may be mailed in or delivered to the box on the door of the RE Office. To facilitate our planning, we ask that registrations be returned by July 1, 2009; however, meeting that deadline does not guarantee a first choice placement.

For those who wish to sign up for a particular session, we will be holding a Registration Day on Wednesday, May 26. Either Cindy or Barbara will be in the Office from 9 – 3 and again from 6:00 – 8:00 PM to assist you. ***If Sunday evening is your first choice, you are strongly advised to register on or before 5/26. Registrations close when the session is filled.***

Please note the following:

- **Children who are under the age of 5 may accompany parents to GOF, but it is the responsibility of parents to supervise them at all times.** There is no charge for children who will be under the age of 5 on 9/1/2009. Please add their names to the registration form, but write 4 years old clearly, so they are not charged.
- **Children in Grades K - 4 must register *and* participate the entire GOF session with an adult.** 5<sup>th</sup> graders are welcome to attend the family session for part or all of the year.
- **Children in grade 5 – 8 must register and participate the entire GOF session with an adult on the premises.** Parents are responsible for their children's behavior during the meal and the intergenerational activities. Parents may participate in the middle school or the adult breakout.
- **Children in grades 9 and 10 must register with a parent, an older sibling, or a Confirmation sponsor.** It is recommended that this person participate in all GOF sessions with their teen.
- Teens in Grades 11 and 12 may register and participate in GoF without an adult.
- **Adults 60 and older may participate free of charge.**
- **Registration and participation at GoF is required of all First Communion and Confirmation candidates. First Communion usually takes place in Grade 2. Confirmation takes place in Grade 10.**

### ***Family-Friendly Flexibility:***

- Parishioners with pre-school children should feel free to have one parent take them home early, if need be, while the other parent remains on site with the older children. Parents with children in the Primary Breakout are welcome to participate in the Adult breakout on another day. Please just let us know.
- If a conflict comes up on your regularly scheduled session, contact Barbara Dane and if room is available, you may attend a different session for that month.
- Our breakout sessions are recommended for the following age groups.
  - Primary session: K – 4 and at least one parent
  - Middle School session: 5 – 8 parents welcome, but not required
  - High School session: 9 – 12 parents welcome, but not required
  - Adult session: Everybody else!!! ☺

Please feel free to adjust these based on your child's specific needs. 5<sup>th</sup> graders are welcome to stay in the family sessions for part or all of the year. Students in grades 11 and 12 are welcome to join the adult session.
